Artificial limb gloves

- A-1 1 artificial limb glove for **passive hands** Model: nappa leather, unlined with topstitching, type of fastener of your choice
- A-2 1 artificial limb glove for **active hands** Model: nappa leather, unlined with topstitching, type of fastener of your choice
- A-3 1 artificial limb glove for **passive hands** Model: suede, unlined with topstitching
- A-4 1 artificial glove for **active hands** Model: suede, unlined with topstitching
- A-5 1 artificial glove, unlined
 1 leather glove, wool-lined
 Model: nappa leather, with topstitching
- A-6 1 artificial limb glove, unlined
 1 leather glove, fur-lined
 Model: nappa leather, with topstitching

Type of fastener of your choice:

- 1. Zip at the inner side of the thumb
- 2. Zip in the palm
- 3. Press studs

- B-1 1 **mitten** wool-lining Model: nappa leather, as pull-on
- B-2 1 mitten fur-lining Model: nappa leather, as pull-on

 D-5 1 hand stump protector made to measure for major deformity.
- D-5 1 hand stump protector made to measure for major deformity fur-lining

The final classification and pricing will be determined upon receipt of the hand outline or plaster mold, with consideration given to the complexity of the hand's structure.



Upper Extremities: Upper arm / forearm

- C-6 1 stump warmer for upper arm or forearm stump wool-lining Model: nappa leather, fastener of your choice
- D-6 1 **stump warmer for upper arm or forearm stump** fur-lining Model: nappa leather, fastener of your choice



- C-7 1 stump warmer "**Krukenberg**" wool-lining Model: nappa leather, fastener of your choice.
- D-7 1 stump warmer "**Krukenberg**" fur-lining Model: nappa leather, fastener of your choice








Bag glove

G-2 1 "bag glove"

Interior lining of your choice Indication: e.g. neurodermatitis, infantile cerebral palsy, etc. Model: bag-shaped, thumbless mitten with side zip and locking Velcro fastener at wrist which cannot be undone by the patient. Plastic strip for opening and closing the locking Velcro fastener.



- To open: insert plastic strip (2) into the protective leather sheath (1) to separate the two sides of the Velcro. Pull out leather tongue (3). Undo zip (4).
- To close: do up zip (4). Insert plastic strip (2) into the protective leather sheath (1). Slide the leather tongue (3) into the protective leather sheath (1) over the plastic strip (2). Remove plastic strip (2). The glove is securely fastened.





Tips for choosing the right materials

Outer leather:

| standard nappa | dress gloves |
|----------------|--|
| | robust work gloves, especially for working out-of-doors (moisture-resistant) |
| • • | work gloves for dry work |
| deerskin | dress gloves, artificial limb gloves |

Lining:

| silk | dress gloves, sensitive hands, little protection against cold |
|-----------------|--|
| wool | dress gloves, thin work gloves |
| lambskin, thin | dress gloves, slightly thicker work gloves, stump protectors, good protection against cold |
| lambskin, thick | dress gloves, heavy-duty work gloves, excellent protection against cold |
| deerskin | for post-operative use when stumps are still very painful and sensitive. Deerskin lining is exceptionally kind to the skin |

Fasteners :

| Pull-on | glove with no fastener, standard model |
|-----------------|--|
| Wedge and bar | comfortable to pull on the glove, good grip |
| Press studs | artificial limb gloves |
| Elasticated | mittens, stump protectors on the hand and forearm, Krukenberg, etc. |
| Velcro fastener | closure on back of hand, highly suitable for work gloves (protective gloves for fitters etc.), consists of elasticated draws with Velcro fastener |
| Zip | "active" artificial limb gloves, for particularly complex hand injuries where pulling a glove on is difficult, such as for spasticity, extreme claw-shaped deformation, transplants, |

hooked thumbs and for highly pain-sensitive hands

Taking measurements correctly = optimal fit

| If possible, always measure both hands Please sketch both hands (provides us with the original shape of the disabled hand) If possible, always sketch the hand straight with the middle finger forming a straight line with the forearm Do not spread the fingers too widely apart |

| If the finger(s) are severely bent, please roll up a thin piece of cardboard, place it in the palm, draw the outline on it and measure the finger length. |
| If there is a protrusion on the back of the hand, please position the hand upright on its side, draw around the hand on its side and measure the protrusion and plot its location. Please still draw the outline of the hand laid flat on the paper. |

For major deformities, please attach pictures.

- 1. If possible, fabrication of a plaster model in neutral position.
- 2. Outline drawing

TIP: Gloves that already fit are highly suitable as patterns, please enclose them.

Tips for the cleaning of gloves

Stained leather

Wipe off stained smooth-leather gloves with a soaped, moist cloth; later wipe it dry.

Protect from sun

In order for your leather gloves not to become spotted, do not leave them lying in the sun for a longer period of time.

Hair shampoo for leather gloves

Stained, brightly-coloured unlined leather gloves may be pulled on and washed in lukewarm soap water, as if washing one's hands. Afterwards, rinse and add a litt-le glycerin to the leftover water for regreasing. Take off the gloves, blow air into the gloves' fingers and hang them up for drying.

Hanging up wet leather

If your gloves have gotten wet, they should be hung up for drying (not at the oven or in front of the radiator). Suede should be brushed accordingly. If the leather has become stiff from moisture, knead it until it is soft again.

Lanolin for smooth leather

Smooth leather gloves stay smooth and do not suffer cracks when lanolin or castor oil is rubbed in and let permeate for some time. Then, polish with a soft cloth.

No chemical substances for suede

Chemical stain removers are not recommended for suede. Ugly marks might appear around the stains and the colour might bleed. Greasy stains might best be removed with a suede cleaning cloth.

Specking stains

Specking stains on suede may be napped with a fine wire or creping brush.

We recommend our leather care products made from organic-certified plant extracts, pharmaceutical-grade raw materials, and organic-certified waxes, crafted in an Austrian manufactory. These products are also dermatologically certified.



Terms of delivery and payment

- The goods remain the property of Hudelist GmbH until payment is received in full.
- Postage and packaging costs are borne by the buyer.
- Payment is due promptly after the receipt of the goods.
- Surcharge for impregnated nappa leather (water-repellent and especially for work gloves): 10%.
- Surcharge for doubly reinforced palm, lashed (especially for work gloves): 10%.
- ◊ Surcharge for suede models: 15%.
- Surcharge for silk lining: 10%.
- Surcharge for press studs, golf fasteners, bar fasteners, zip, wedges, Velcro fastenings (if not part of that model) is calculated as per current price list.
- Models, drawings and sewing patterns are archived for future supplies.

Warranty

We guarantee,

- that the leathers comply with the German PCP-regulation from 12/12/1998 (max. 5ppm-mg/kg).
- that the leathers do not contain any forbidden AZO dyes (in accordance with the Consumer Goods Ordinance)
- that the leathers do not contain allergenic emulsion particles
- that the leathers do not contain chromium VI or free chromium III above the legally permitted concentration.
